Application Procedure

1. Complete the Summer Application Form.

2. Fill out the top part of the Summer Program Reference Form then have it completed by a faculty member. Please collect your Reference Forms from your Faculty referees in sealed envelopes and submit them with your Application Form. If you are applying for a Language & Literature Program, your reference must be completed by a university language professor. Non-VU students are required to submit 2 completed Reference Forms.

3. Unless otherwise instructed in the specific program description under Special Instructions, submit your complete Summer Application to the Faculty Program Coordinator and arrange an interview time. A complete Summer Application includes the following:

- Completed Summer Application Form
- VU students: Completed Reference Forms
- Non-VU students: Completed Reference Forms
- Non-VU students: Official university transcripts

Unless otherwise instructed in the specific program description under Special Instructions, applications will be processed and acceptance letters e-mailed on or about the 1st of every month. A non-refundable deposit of \$450 is due to the Bureau's Office upon receipt of an acceptance letter.

4. Students accepted to all VU International Summer Programs are required to submit the following documents to the Office of International Studies:

- Signed Release — this will be distributed at Orientation
- Copy of the photo page of the Passport
- Copy of the Visa (if applicable)
- Copy of the High Inventory
- Two Passport Photos — photocopies, scanned images, and colored snapshots will NOT be accepted. NOTICE: Some programs do not require passport pictures. Please refer to acceptance letter for individual program requirements.
- Medical Form — this should be completed by your family physician and mailed to the Office of International Studies. Not every student will need to complete this form.

- 2.5 GPA or better on a 4.0 scale; non-Villanova students must submit a recent official transcript of undergraduate work
- Full-time university status without disciplinary probation
- Complete Application submitted to the Faculty Program Coordinator by Friday, March 3, 2006 unless otherwise instructed in the specific program description under Special Instructions.
- An interview with the Faculty Program Coordinator is required in order to be accepted into any program.
- All non-VU students must contact the Faculty Program Coordinator directly for additional information.
- Orientation is all pre-departure orientation sessions as required by the Faculty Program Coordinator.
- Students will receive letter grades for all VU summer programs.
- Students must attend programs through the stated dates. Early departures are not allowed.
- Additional Academic Requirements and/or Special Instructions may be included in the specific program description.
